Charging Policy

1 Introduction

1.1 Al-Noor Primary is an independent school and thus a 'fee-paying' school. The school fees are based upon a policy of investing in our teachers and school resources so that we can provide high quality of education.

1.2 The school fees are set out in the school prospectus and application form which every parent receives on their child's enrolment.

2 Voluntary contributions

2.1 School trips enrich the educational experience of pupils and are an integral part of the school curriculum. All pupils are required to attend them.

2.2 The costs for trips are not covered in school fees and therefore parents are charged for them. Staff members organising school trips try to keep costs minimal. Costs are determined by entry fees and travel.

2.3 Trips take place at least once a half term and are listed in the appendices of the school's curriculum policy.

3 Monitoring & review

3.1 This policy is monitored by the Board of trustees' Education sub-committee.

3.2 The Education Team evaluate and review this policy once every three years or sooner if needed.
